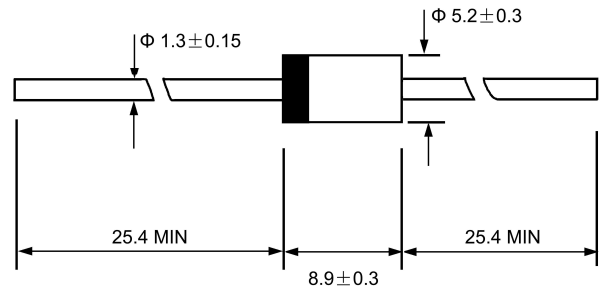

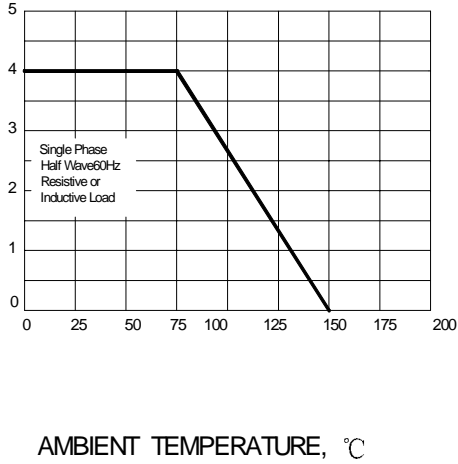

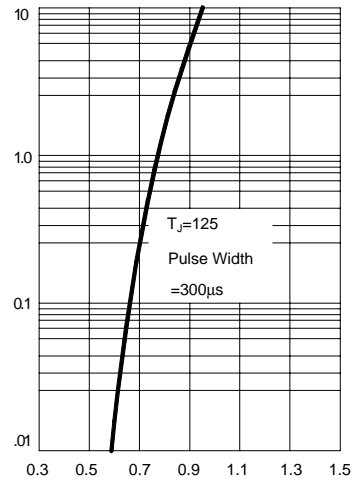

AMPERES

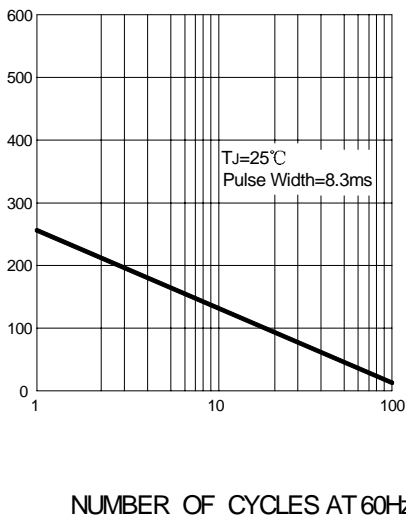
**FIG.2 – TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS**

**FIG.3 – MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT**

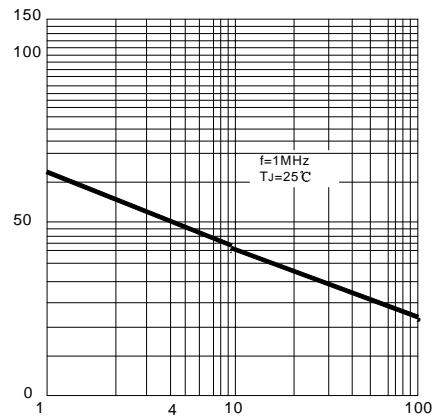
PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT
